DOUBLE CIRCLE TYPES (NIJU-MARU)

Found chiefly on the Koban Series of stamps. Introduced in 1888 to cancel postage stamps used for payment of telegraph fees after the discontinuance of the special ten cent telegraph stamps.



KOREA USUAGE

After Japan annexed Korea in 1910, only Japanese stamps were used.

This lasted until 1945, when Japan surrendered to the Allies.
