Chinese Junk Issues - International Registered Letter



Canton to Germany, 23 Dec 1922, shows colorful combination of stamps making up the international registered letter rate of 15 cents for the first half ounce, and 15 cents for registration, both rates effective 1 Nov 22 until 31 Dec 23. The reverse shows a boxed rubber handstamp of Canton where the registration number is entered by hand. Cover slightly trimmed at top.

Chinese Junk Issues - International Mail Printed Matter



Canton datestamp used on printed matter mail - all Chinese cancels stamp, typical 27 mm cds on back, bi-lingual Canton and English date.

Canton to USA, 30 May 1922, surface letter sent at 2 cent rate effective from 5 Aug 1910 to 31 Oct 1922; rate for printed matter up to 50 grams.

Chinese Junk Issues - International Mail



Canton to USA, Sub-Office No. 10, 15 March 1919, 20 gram surface letter sent at 10 cent rate effective from 5 Aug 1910 to 31 Oct 1922; and, Sub-Office No. 8, 21 Nov 1922, international letter rate of 15 cents for first 20 grams effective from 1 Nov 1922 to 31 Dec 1922.



International postcard rate effective 1 Jan 1923 to 30 June 1930
Surface rate = 0.10 for the first 20 grams



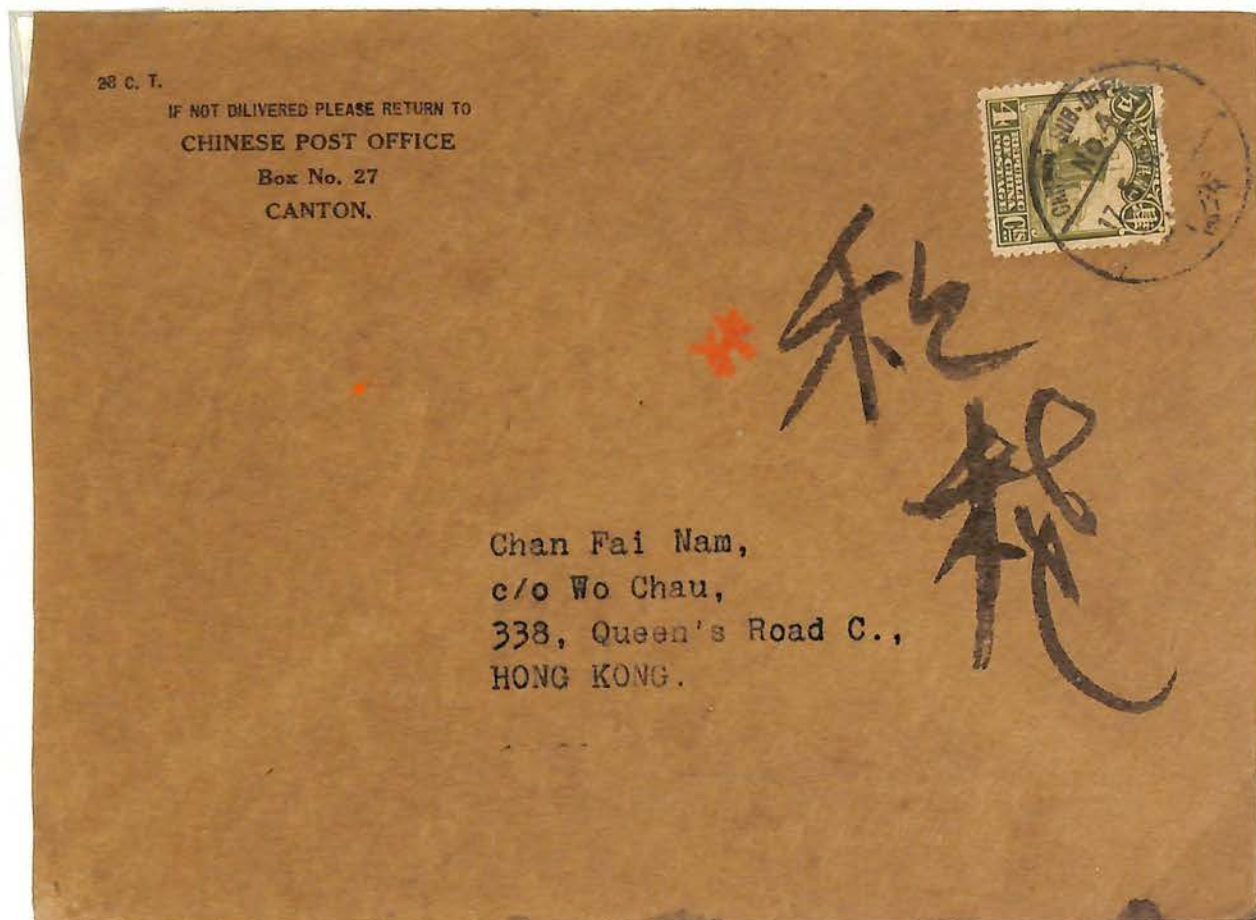
Canton to France, 20 NOV 1923 and to Czechoslovakia on 5 Nov 1927, showing the single international postcard rate of \$0.06. The former has a French arrival datestamp. The latter shows a CANTON 3 datestamp with arabic numeral date plus a Port Said, Egypt transit mark of 4 DEC 1927.

Surface Letter to Hong Kong rate: 4 cents per each 20 grams,
effective 5 August 1910 to 30 April 1933.

Canton to Hong Kong, 5 June 1931, surface letter paid by 4 cent stamp, cancelled by large circular
CANTON SUB-OFFICE NO. 4 datestamp postmark. Hong Kong receiver, 6 JUN 31, on back.

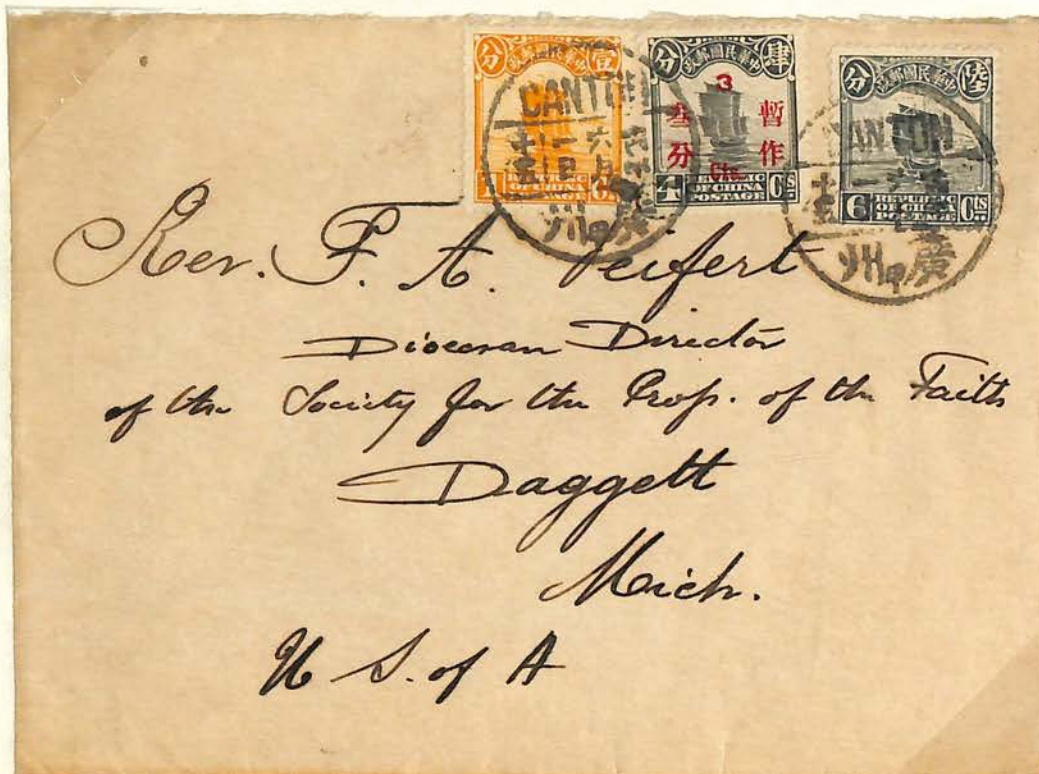
