Temple of Heaven - Beijing. Constitutional Issue (Limited use in Sinkiang) - 1923

On October 10, 1923, the Republic of China formally adopted its national constitution at the Temple of Heaven in Beijing. In the stamp design, crossed Republic of China flags guard the entrance. Zhang Zuolin, a warlord from Manchuria, expanded his territory into northern China, gaining control of Beijing in 1926. When he died in 1928 after a bomb blew up his train, these stamps were withdrawn. These stamps were issued on the 17th of October 1923.

The characters "新疆貼用" (for use in Sinkiang) in Regular-Writing style were overprinted in two vertical lines over the rice stalks on both sides of the stamps by the Peiping Printing Bureau of the Ministry of Finance.

General Chiang Kai-shek – Unification of the Country (Limited use in Sinkiang) - 1929

Chiang Kai-shek (1887 – 1975) was a soldier and statesman, head of the Nationalist government in China from 1928 to 1949 and subsequently head of the Chinese Nationalist government in exile on Taiwan. In 1918 he joined Sun Yat-sen, the leader of the Nationalist Party or Kuomintang. Sun's chief concern was to reunify China, he became commandant of a military academy, established on the Soviet model, at Whampoa, near Guangzhou. Chiang was the strongest of Sun's heirs. By alternate shows of force and leniency, he attempted to stem the communists' growing influence without losing Soviet support. Moscow supported him until 1927, when, in a bloody coup of his own, he finally broke with the communists. Chiang Kai-shek first appeared on a Chinese postage stamp on April 18, 1929, to commemorate the unification of China. 25th Anniversary of Postal Service
(Limited use in Sinkiang) - 1921

On the 7th day of the 2nd moon of the 22nd year of Emperor Kuang Hsu (March 20, 1896), the Yamen in charge of foreign affairs (Ministry of Foreign Affairs) obtained a court edict for the conversion of the Postal Service, then under concurrent charge of the Customs, into a separate Postal Administration. After lengthy preparations, the Administration came into existence in the following year. Although the Postal Administration was housed in the Customs House at its inception, it functioned independently. On the completion of its 25th year of service on March 20, 1921, the Postal Administration issued a set of commemorative stamps to mark the occasion with a design bearing the portrait of President Hsu Shi-chang in the middle, Prime Minister Chin Yun-peng on the right, and Minister of Communications Yeh Kung-cho on the left, with rice heads as decorations. As the printing was not completed on the Postal Day, the stamps were placed on sale on October 10, the Anniversary of the Republic.

General Chang Tso-Lin - Assumption of Power
(Limited use in Sinkiang)

The postal system in Sinkiang was inaugurated by the Russians. Covers mailed from Chinese post offices in Sinkiang during the Ching dynasty are quite rare. Chinese postage stamps without overprints were used until 1915. In the 1930s and 40s, red or violet postmarks were used to indicate censorship. The issue of stamps overprinted "for use in Sinkiang" finished in 1945 and ordinary Chinese stamps were used since then. On June 18, 1927, General Chang Tso-Lin declared himself as the Commander-in-Chief of the Army and Navy and ordered the printing of stamps to commemorate the occasion. These stamps were issued on March 1 in the following year. His portrait is the central design with rice stalks on both sides and two flags intersecting at the top. One of these is the navy flag and the other the then national flag. These stamps were used in Chihli (Hopeh), Shantung, Fengtien (Liaoning), Kirin, Heilungkiang, and Sinkiang provinces only. In June 1928, Chang was killed during a retreat, so the sale of these stamps were consequently suspended.

Dr. Sun Yat-sen's State Burial (Limited use in Sinkiang) - 1929

After years of unremitting toil and hardship in the cause of national revolution, Dr. Sun Yat-sen died in Peiping on March 12, 1925. He was buried in a mausoleum on the slope of Purple Mountain, Nanking. In commemoration of the state burial, the Postal Administration issued a set of commemorative stamps with the Memorial Hall in front of the Mausoleum decorated on the two sides by rice stalks as the central design. These stamps were issued on the 15th of July 1929.

The characters "新疆貼用" (for use in Sinkiang) in Regular-Writing style were overprinted in two vertical lines over the rice stalks on both sides of the stamps by the Peiping Printing Bureau of the Ministry of Finance.

Imperial Chinese Post – Coiling Dragons

The first regular issue of the ICP Coiling Dragons was on October 1st, 1897. Formerly called and best known as the Lithographed Coiling Dragons. This set of definitives was designed by R. A. de Villard & engraved & printed in Japan by retired Italian artist and master engraver Edoardo Chiossone. Due to some issues with the printing quality and delayed delivery, IPO decided to order another set of definitives from Waterlow & Sons Limited, London. The Waterlow, London print was called the CIP Issue for the English inscription of that issue is Chinese Imperial Post.
